

A COUNTRY BOUTIQUE

We extend this opportunity to Home Arts exhibitors to sell their handcrafted items in the Belotti Hall Country Boutique. Unfortunately, we are no longer able to sell jams and jellies.

To be eligible, the following guidelines must be followed.

1. Participants must enter at least two classes in the following Adult Home Arts Department divisions: Machine Sewn Items and Embroidery, Knitting, Crocheting, Quilts, Miscellaneous Crafts, Needle Art, Fine Threaded Needle, Handcrafted Natural Fibers or Rugs.
2. Items to be sold need not be entered for competition. You may sell entered items but they will be displayed with their respective class and must remain for the duration of the fair.
3. A commission of 10% and sales tax will be charged.
4. Amateur status will not be affected by participation in this boutique.
5. All items must be brought to Belotti Hall on entry days, August 3 & 4. Each item must have a secure price tag attached with the sale price and the exhibitor's code that will be provided at time of entry. Written inventory must be provided with items.
6. Supervisors reserve the right to refuse items not suitable for display and may limit the number of items sold by each exhibitor, if necessary.
7. The Humboldt County Fair management and employees will not be held responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items.
