- 4** Exhibitor's name and city must be on **ONE COPY ONLY**.

Judging will be done prior to Fair, using American system of judging. Management reserves the right to eliminate from judging any entry that is not in the best interest of the Fair or is inappropriate.

Published poems or those previously awarded cash prizes in any competition are ineligible. Poems remain the property of the author and will be destroyed if not picked up after the Fair. Anyone wishing to have poems returned by mail must enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
