

WRISTBAND INFORMATION

- 1 Each youth animal exhibitor may buy one wristband at \$5 between 10 am & 8 pm on weigh-in day only at a spot designated by Admissions Department near the Livestock Office. Anyone unable to pick up bands at that time must submit a request for variance to Fair office prior to Fair.** Wristband will be put on at time of purchase or entry into Fair and checked for alteration or damage on each entry into Fair. Parking passes will be in exhibitor packets picked up at weigh-in.
- 2 Families of youth animal exhibitors may buy up to three wristbands for \$5 each only between 10 am & 8 pm on weigh-in day only, limit three to a family. Anyone unable to pick up bands at that time must submit a request for variance to Fair office prior to Fair.** Families are urged to buy pre-sale admission tickets from Fair office for additional family members. Deadline for pre-sale ticket purchase is Monday, Aug 9. Youth exhibitor/family wristband credentials shall be valid for six days, inclusive of weigh-in day and through the final day of Fair. One band will be replaced at no cost if all pieces are presented at Fair office. Lost bands or second damaged band must be purchased at full gate price.
- 3 Adult animal exhibitors will receive four wristbands at no charge only between 9 am & 3 pm on check-in day only at a spot designated by Admissions Department near the Livestock Office. Anyone unable to pick up bands at that time must submit a request for variance in writing to Fair office before Fair.** Wristbands shall be valid for five days, inclusive of opening day and through Sunday, Aug. 15. One band will be replaced at no cost if all pieces are presented at Fair office. Lost bands or second damaged band must be purchased at full gate price. Exhibitors are urged to purchase pre-sale admission tickets from Fair office for additional handlers and family. Deadline for pre-sale ticket purchase is Monday, Aug. 9.
- 4 Wristbands for exhibitors, families and handlers will be available only at designated times on weigh-in day only for youth and opening day only for adults. They will be distributed only by admission personnel only at a location near the Livestock Office to be specified on check-in and weigh-in days. See Rules 1, 2 & 3 above.**

TRAILER PASSES

- 1 Trailer passes must be placed in the window of your RV or trailer for admittance to campground. Remove tow vehicles from campground to Exhibitor Parking. Tow and/or delivery vehicles will not be allowed back into camp lot until after Fair is over. Make sure to bring all necessary goods and equipment on weigh-in day.**
- 2 The campground area will be opened and supervised by security personnel beginning at 1 p.m. Mon, Aug 16. Rule violations will result in the loss of camping privileges for the remainder of the Fair, as well as loss of privilege of selling at Junior Livestock Auction.**
