3 Cavy (not sanctioned)

RULES

- **YOUTH EXHIBITORS, NOT PARENTS, MUST GROOM AND CARE FOR EXHIBITS FOR THE ENTIRE WEEK.**
- Sanctioned ARBA youth show open to youth through the age of 18.
- Out of county residents welcome.
- Do not combine rabbits with any other item on entry forms.
- All animals must be purebred and **identified by permanent ear marking (tattoo number)** conforming to the entry form when they arrive at the show.
- Entries will be separated into breeds and classes when entered into computer. On entry form state breed, variety, color, sex, age.
- Animals entered in fur class must also be entered in breeding class.
- Youth display exhibitors will receive passes from admissions personnel at a location near Livestock Office when they check-in their animals Aug 17.
- No substitutions, changes or additions after Aug 9.
- Ear number changes to be made at check-in as long as same sex, breed, variety & age.
- This ARBA sanctioned youth show will be governed by the latest rules of ARBA, with the exception of Showmanship. Showmanship will abide by 4-H and FFA rules. Filing of entry implies acceptance of these rules.
- Youth may enter Open Show.
- No sales sign on rabbits not checked into designated sales area. Fair retains 20% commission on all sales.

MEAT PEN RULES

- All applicable Youth Livestock Auction rules apply.
- Meat pen competition judged by current ARBA rules.
- Rabbits entered in Div. 455 are limited to Humboldt County residents only
- Meat pens consist of three rabbits 3 lbs. to 5 lbs. each and not over 70 days old. Animals to be the same breed and variety. Exhibitor must own the mother of the litter when the litter is born and must own animals 30 consecutive days prior to Fair.
- Auction meat pens to be judged Wed, Aug 18, 11 am in Rabbit Barn
- Sale weight will be determined at time of judging.
- Seller to provide processing arrangements.
- Specify on form 4-H or FFA.
- 4-H & independent exhibitors show together in Meat Pen Division.
- Champion and reserve champion meat rabbits are eligible to sell at the Youth Livestock Auction. Eligible sellers must attend auction orientation meeting Sat, Aug 21, 2 pm in the Covered Arena.
- Exhibitors must be at least 9 years of age on Jan. 1 of Fair year to enter Div. 451.

DIVISION 452 - SHOWMANSHIP (To enter rabbits must be entered in show.) No entry fee
