## **DIVISION 750 – TRACTOR DRIVING CONTEST**

- Class 1** Beginning (age 9-12\*)  
**2** Intermediate (age 13-15\*)  
**3** Advanced (age 16-18\*) \*age 1<sup>st</sup> day of Fair

Contest is judged on a written test on tractor principles, maintenance and safety in addition to a test of operating skill and safety. Contestants must pass the written test before being allowed to participate in the actual driving test. Except in the advanced class, winners of an age class must move to the next age division.

## **ATTENTION LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS**

Only first bedding of straw provided by Fairgrounds, one bale per animal to a maximum of five bales. Straw available only Mon, Aug 11, after 4 pm, or Tues, Aug 12, until it is all gone.
