## **DIVISION 750 – TRACTOR DRIVING CONTEST**

- Class 1** Beginning (age 9-12\*)

Contest is judged on a written test on tractor principles, maintenance and safety in addition to a test of operating skill and safety. Contestants must pass the written test before being allowed to participate in the actual driving test. Except in the advanced class, winners of an age class must move to the next age division.
