Dear Humboldt County Livestock Board,

My name is Graci Elmore and I will be a senior at Fortuna High School. I have been participating in their FFA program since I was in the 8th grade, and I have been bringing animals to the Humboldt County Fair since I was 8 years old. My project this year is a market steer. I have had my project since November of 2025 and for these past 7 months, I have been raising him up to be a premium quality market steer.

I am writing to the board to explain a situation with me personally that may need an allowance not usual for participants. I am having a major facial reconstructive surgery on July 13th. My upper jaw will essentially be broken and repositioned using plates and screws. My recovery time will be 4 to 6 weeks at the bare minimum which puts me in a very tough position since fair will be just at the 4 week mark of my recovery.

I have every intention of putting 100 percent into remaining healthy and recovering quickly but there is a high probability that my surgeons may not agree it is a good idea to show my steer. I will be at the fair, and plan to be in my show whites for the market class and on sale day, but am requesting the possibility of standing ringside. So my plea to the board is that you would allow a fellow participant to assist me in showing and selling my steer so that I may complete my project this year. I am more than willing to answer any questions that may arise or explain more if needed. Thank you for your consideration!
