4 Simple Steps to Purchasing an Animal

1. Register as a Buyer

New Buyers can register at the bankers table on the day of the auction.

Previous Buyers will automatically receive buyer's numbers in the mail, and should log onto the fair website to update contact information.

2. After your Purchase

Following the winning bid, buyers ware asked to have their photo taken with the exhibitor.

At that time, you will be asked to sign a sales slip verifying the price of the animal and your preferences for handling your purchase, cut & wrap, donation, and resale.

3. Add- On Bids

A great way to help an exhibitor, without the obligation of purchasing an entire animal, is to add-on to their sale price. Individuals are able to add-on any desired dollar amount to the final price the seller will receive for their animal.

Add-ons are open for one week after the auction and can be made through the HCF Website!

4. Payment Options

Many youth have loans/costs that require repayment from the sale, so prompt payment is necessary. Same day payment is expected. Cashiers will be present on site during the sale to help with these purchases. Checks, cash, Visa & MasterCard are accepted.
